The Seven Pillars of Wisdom

"Wisdom has built her house, she has hewed out her seven pillars: she has killed her beasts; she has mingled her wine; she has also furnished her table. She has sent forth her maidens: she cries upon the highest places of the city, whoso is simple, let him turn in hither: as for him that wants understanding, she says to him, Come, eat of my bread, and drink of the wine which I have mingled. Forsake the foolish, and live; and go in the way of understanding," Proverbs 9:1-6.

The seven pillars of wisdom are spoken of in Proverbs 8:11-20 and Isaiah 11:2-4, also called the seven Spirits of Yahweh (Revelation 1:4; 4:5; 5:6).

"And out of the throne proceeded lightnings and thunderings and voices; and there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of Elohim," Revelation 4:5.

"And the Spirit of Yahweh shall rest upon him, the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and the fear of Yahweh; And shall make him of quick understanding in the fear of Yahweh: and he shall not judge after the sight of his eyes, neither reprove after the hearing of his ears: but with righteousness shall he judge the poor,

and reprove with equity for the meek of the earth: and he shall smite the earth with the rod of his mouth, and with the breath of his lips shall he slay the wicked," Isaiah 11:2-4.

The seven pillars of wisdom as set forth above are:

1. Wisdom — James 1:5
2. Understanding — Proverbs 9:10
3. Counsel — Proverbs 8:4; Isaiah 9:6; John 15:26; 16:3
4. Might — Micah 3:8; Exodus 14:13-14; Isaiah 41:10
5. Knowledge — Isaiah 28:9-10; Psalms 119:11
6. Fear of Yahweh — Proverbs 15:33; 16:6
7. Right Judgment — Zechariah 7:9; 8:16-17; James 1:27

It is in these seven pillars, Yahweh's ruach ha-godesh (the Holy Spirit), that one may find truth, guidance, comfort and understanding. But what is knowledge without love? or faith without obedience? With the guidance of Yahweh's Holy Spirit Scripture has revealed the treasures contained therein and herein I set before you that which has been shown.
